




Driving Roundabouts

First, determine where you want to go.



Going Right



1. Slow down and prepare to YIELD as you approach the roundabout.
2. Indicate a right turn.
3. YIELD to pedestrians and bicyclists crossing at the designated crosswalks.
4. You must YIELD to traffic already in the roundabout.
5. Enter the roundabout when there is a safe gap in the traffic and travel in a counter clockwise direction.
6. Look for your street, use your right-turn signal, and exit the roundabout.
7. As you exit the roundabout, YIELD for any pedestrians or bicyclists crossing at the designated crosswalks.

Going Straight Ahead




1. Slow down and prepare to YIELD as you approach the roundabout.
2. When going straight ahead you do not need to indicate on approach.
3. YIELD to pedestrians and bicyclists crossing at the designated crosswalks.
4. You must YIELD to traffic already in the roundabout.
5. Enter the roundabout when there is a safe gap in the traffic and travel in a counter clockwise direction.
6. As you exit the roundabout, YIELD for any pedestrians or bicyclists crossing at the designated crosswalks.

Going Left



1. Slow down and prepare to YIELD as you approach the roundabout.
2. YIELD to pedestrians and bicyclists crossing at the designated crosswalks.
3. You must YIELD to traffic already in the roundabout.
4. Enter the roundabout when there is a safe gap in the traffic and travel in a counter clockwise direction.
5. Look for your street, use your right-turn signal, and exit the roundabout.
6. As you exit the roundabout, YIELD for any pedestrians or bicyclists crossing at the designated crosswalks.
