REPLICA OF THE VIETNAM WALL

Utah's Vietnam Veterans of America, in partnership with Layton City, is raising funds to bring a replica of the Vietnam Memorial Wall to a permanent home in Layton Commons Park. The Memorial Wall will be 80 percent of the size (approx. 340' long) of the Vietnam Memorial Wall in Washington, D.C. It will contain all 58,307 names of the men and women lost in Vietnam.

Many of the brave men and women on the wall served in Vietnam for only \$4.42 a day. This amount equates to 18 cents an hour for their service to the United States. Utah's Vietnam Veterans of America are asking for donations of \$4.42 to help make this a reality. These service members gave their all for \$4.42 a day, would you?
